Clicking on the  button will always return you to the beginning of SFFIND.



Use of Pan button



User clicks on the  button, then clicks and hold down on a location on the map - then drag the map to the desired location.



Use of zoom in button




User clicks on the  button, then clicks and holds down on the map, dragging a rectangular box around the area you would like to zoom to.



Use of the zoom out button



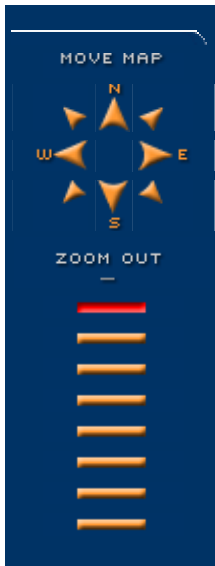
User clicks on the  button, then clicks once on the map where you would like to zoom out from.



Use of the identify button

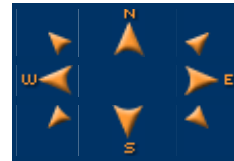


User clicks on the  button, then clicks on a location on the map where you would like information.



Alternative zooming and panning

The map location bar provides the user with an alternative way to zoom in and out, as well as pan around on the SFFIND map. Similar to other mapping applications on the web, the pan location bar permits panning in 8 different directions:



The zoom out bars allow for the user to pick a specific zoom scale directly.

Building a search

The SFFIND query builder allows users to search for information geographically (by knowing the location), or by a specific resource or service. Users can build their question dynamically by selecting a particular:

- Supervisory District;
- Neighborhood;
- Address; or
- Services by category

Turning layers on and off in SFFIND is easy: All the user must do is check which layer you

would like displayed, then hit the Button. All information should display regardless of scale, except for **Aerial photography** - you must be zoomed into a scale of less than 500 feet = inch.

The public art sites search selection under 'services by category' pulls up the form to the left. Users can look for a particular art resource by its name, and then find its location.

Services by Category - Homeless services

The Homeless services search under 'services by category' pulls up the form to the left. Users can look for a particular homeless services by name, service keywords, or by specific services offered. Clicking on the 'find homeless services' button then finds its location.
